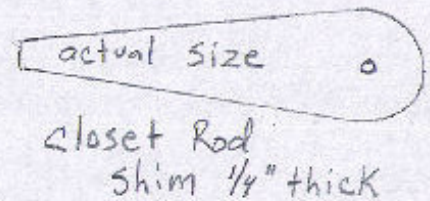
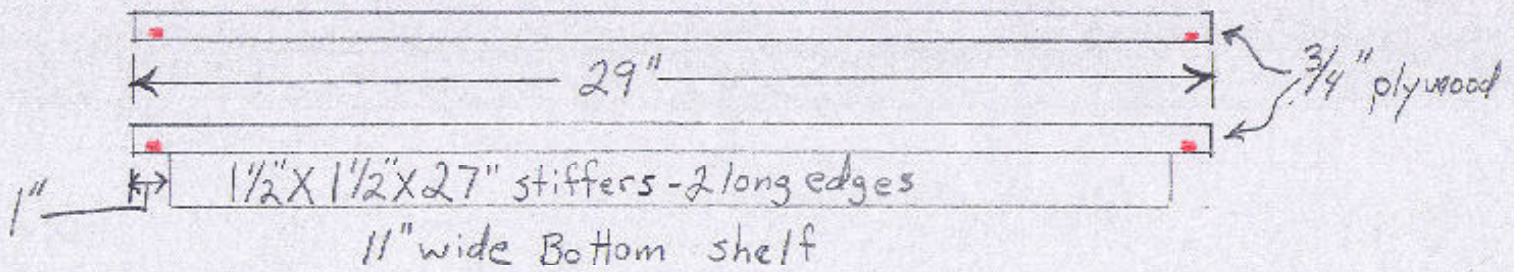


11" wide Top shelf



Use 2 layers of $\frac{3}{4}$ " exterior plywood for the posts to help stop twisting & warping. Use $\frac{3}{4}$ " plywood for the shelves for the same reason... less likely to cup or twist than solid $\frac{3}{4}$ " pine.

2X6 and 2X4 Pine works O.K. for Foot & shelf supports but you could double up 2 layers of $\frac{3}{4}$ " plywood also. Use dowel pins @ shelves for knockdown units, or screws for more permanent units.
